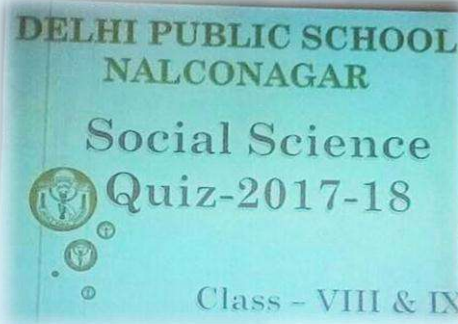


TABLE LAYING COMPETITION (28TH JULY '17)

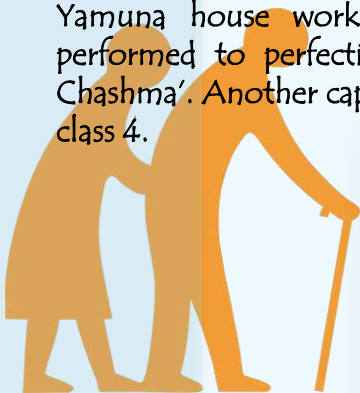
INTERNATIONAL TIGERS' DAY (29TH AUGUST'17)
